TURNING FARMLAND INTO CONSERVATION LAND & BUILDING A RESEARCH STATION by Ulf Tubbesing

Game ranching has, over the past two to three decades, contributed greatly to conservation in Namibia. Numbers of game on private farmland (comprising 43% of the country's surface area) have more than tripled and are exceeding those in Namibian national parks. Since Namibian national parks are under severe tourism pressure (even moderate tourism pressure impacts significantly on arid habitats) and with Namibia's increasing popularity as a tourist destination, there is a great need to increase the total area under conservation in Namibia. Due to budget limitations and pressing sociological needs, our government does not view the addition of more land for conservation purposes a priority. This then places the responsibility (and opportunity) of future expansion of conservation land into the hands of the private sector. > More
